

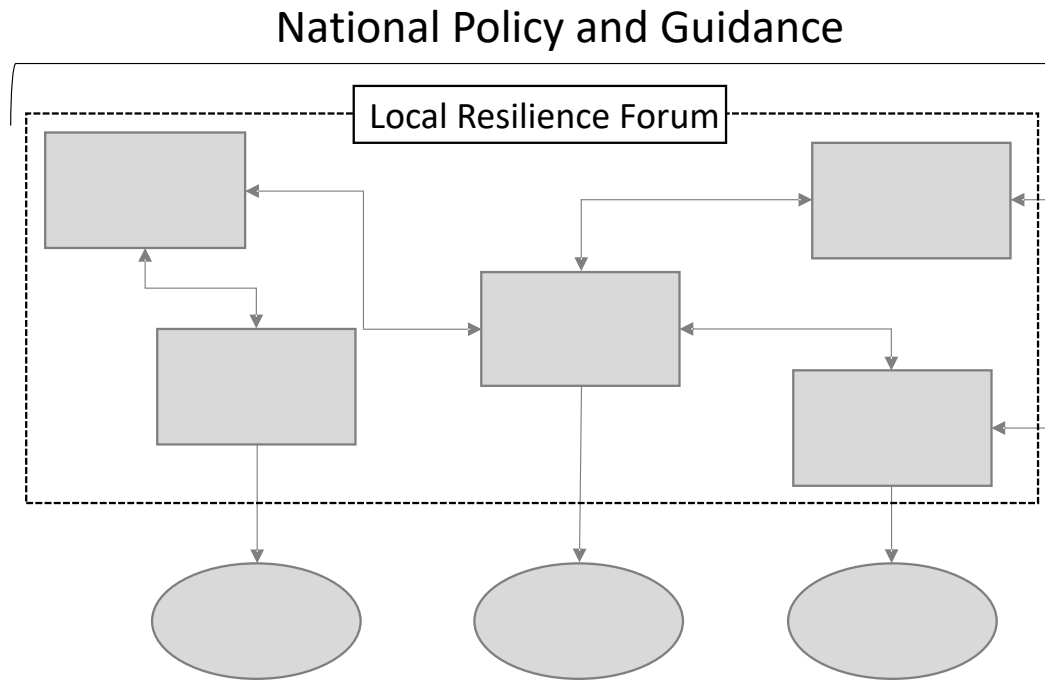

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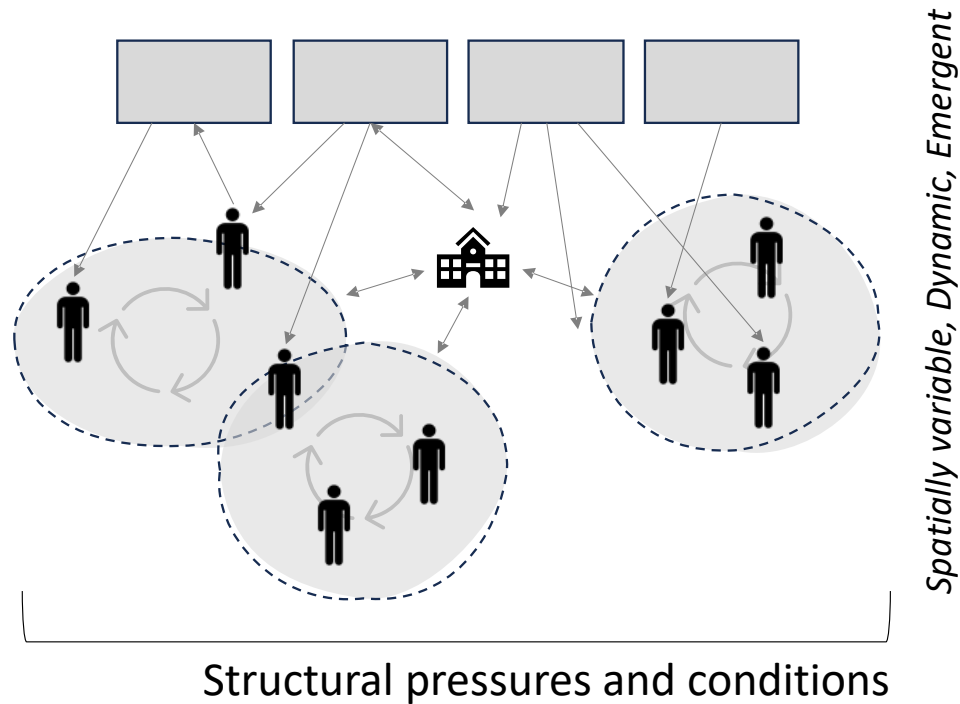
# What is resilience? Traditional approaches

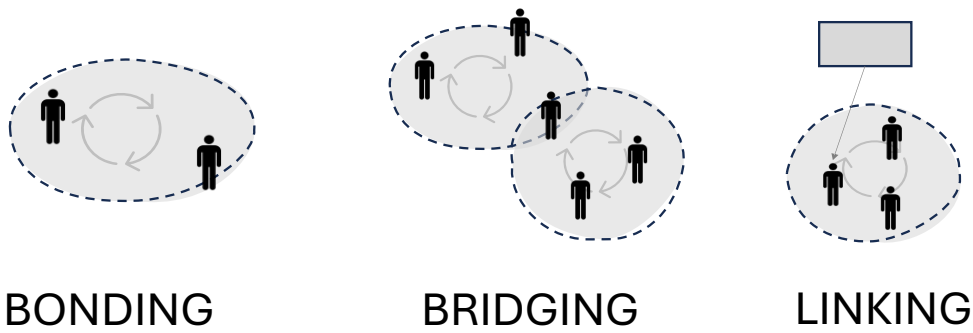

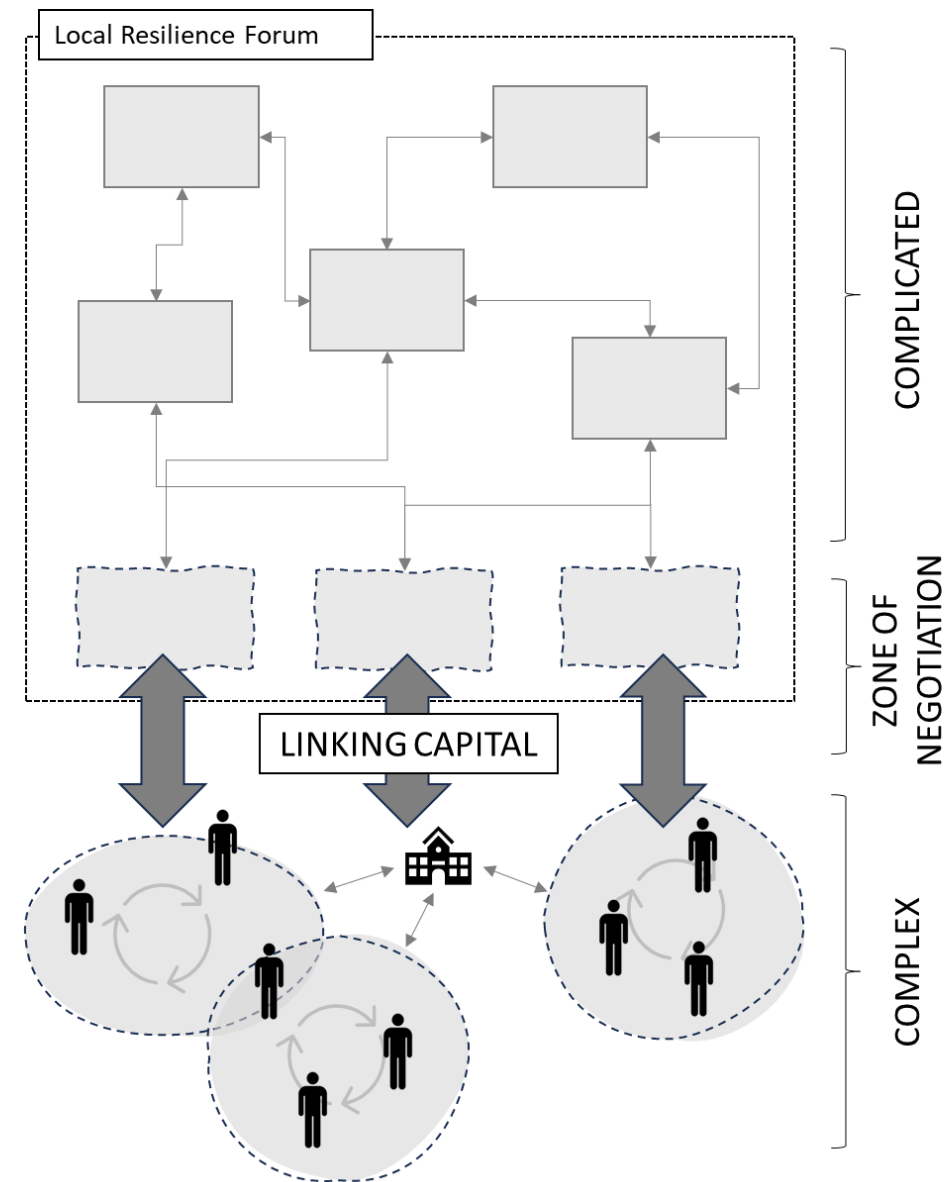
*“it’s important to do positive things which make people feel good about their community and want to participate”*
